REPORT FROM REV. PETER MAGANDA, DEAN, LUTHERAN CHURCH OF UGANDA, EASTERN DEANERY

Greetings dear friends of Lutheran Lay Renewal. I am excited to share with you about the ministry activities here in Eastern Deanery and Serere District.

Leadership Training

This program is supported by Lutheran Lay Renewal, and it has greatly impacted the Lutheran Church of Uganda, especially in preparing students for seminary training and to become evangelists. The new class of 2024/2025 has 13 students who come from different congregations in the Eastern Deanery. These men are well equipped to support ordained ministers in the daily running of church activities, especially leading worship, evangelism and teaching of the Christian faith in the congregations and schools.

Naigobya Lutheran Church, Health Center, and Schools

LCU in Eastern Deanery is grateful for the support given by Lutheran Lay Renewal to the community of Naigobya to acquire more land on which the school can be expanded. We have added more two acres and there are more opportunities for expansion. The school of Naigobya is happy for receiving desks which will enable students to sit comfortably in class and ease writing. The Health Center is greatly helping the communities around it. Many walk long distances to come to our facility for medication. The only challenge now is the lack of a maternity ward to help the pregnant mothers. The community committed herself to provide all the bricks needed to complete the maternity ward once support is available and that will be their contribution.

The school is greatly improving because of the enrolled number of students who have exceeded the number we expected and there is another demand for a three-classroom block. Currently the enrollment is 290 students with six teachers.



Serere

The ministry in Serere, Ojeburun is taking root. Vicar Leonard Opeede spent the week of 24th to 29th January in Serere, teaching the people of the community about Jesus Christ, and he is starting to teach students under a leadership class on 15th July this year.


Christian greetings from the Diocese of Northwest Ankole. Praise the Living God.

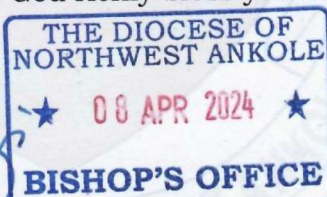
We believe the Holy Spirit will continue to grow and develop the Diocese of Northwest Ankole to greater heights for God's glory.

OUR PARTNERS IN AFRICA NEED OUR FINANCIAL SUPPORT

The financial needs of our partners in Africa are great, as Uganda and Rwanda are two of the 25 poorest countries in the world. Below is a wish list of current financial needs. Would you or your congregation be willing to help?

Lutheran Church of Uganda

Plans are being made to build a maternity block at Naigobya Medical Clinic, a clinic we have been funding for 5 years. We do not yet know the cost but funds will be needed for this project.

\$355 will pay the salaries of 6 teachers & the principal at a primary school for 1 month.

\$1,500 will buy a motorcycle for a pastor or vicar. At least three motorcycles are needed. Many pastors and vicars serving rural congregations must walk long distances every week to minister to their congregations.

Triangular Communities – Iganga, Uganda

Vision: To see all children and girls enter adulthood with holistic skills and abilities necessary to contribute effectively to the development of Uganda.

Josiah Youth and Child Care Center – Ibanda, Uganda

Josiah Youth and Child Care Africa is dedicated to nurturing the potential of youth by providing a diverse range of educational, skill-building, and mentorship programs.

Guided by our core values, we aim to foster personal growth, inspire leadership, and create a supportive environment where each individual can thrive.

Reformed Lutheran Church of Rwanda

Funds are needed to build a church building for the Lutheran congregation in Ntoma, which currently is using a rental house. "Please, we need to build our own church building in Ntoma. Your prayers for the work of God in Rwanda will continue to be a blessing. Adult members are 120, and the total believers including youth and children are over 300." - Pastor Jean Claude Maniragaba, President, Reformed Lutheran Church of Rwanda
