## **LAND PURCHASE FOR BUZIBIRIRA LUTHERAN CHURCH**

Thanks to a very generous U.S. donor, Lutheran Lay Renewal was able to send enough funds to the Eastern Deanery of the Lutheran Church of Uganda to purchase two and a quarter acres of land for this congregation. The land also comes with a building that has many options for use by the congregation, including as a temporary worship facility. This congregation has been trying to raise funds for a land purchase for many years and has been asking us for help since our Executive Director first visited in 2019.

## SERERE LUTHERAN CHURCH

Sunday Worship and catechism classes are now being held at Serere Lutheran Church, Lutheran Church of Uganda Eastern Deanery, on the four acres of land purchased for the congregation with funds sent by Lutheran Lay Renewal of America in 2023, again thanks to a very generous donation to our ministry from a U.S. donor for this purpose. This is the first Lutheran congregation in Serere District, a remote district, and the land is on a peninsula on the eastern side of Lake Kyoga.

## **OUR PARTNERS IN AFRICA NEED OUR FINANCIAL SUPPORT!**

The financial needs of our partners in Africa are great, as Uganda and Rwanda are two of the 25 poorest countries in the world. Below is a wish list of current financial needs. Would you or your congregation be willing to help?

### **Lutheran Church of Uganda**

Plans are being made to build a maternity block at Naigobya Medical Clinic, a clinic we have been funding for 5 years. We do not yet know the cost but funds are needed. \$355 will pay the salaries of 6 teachers & the principal at a primary school for 1 month. \$1,500 will buy a motorcycle for a pastor or vicar. At least three motorcycles are needed. Many pastors and vicars serving rural congregations must walk long distances every week to minister to their congregations.

### **Josiah Youth and Child Care Center – Ibanda, Uganda**

Josiah Youth and Child Care Africa is dedicated to nurturing the potential of youth by providing a diverse range of educational, skill-building, and mentorship programs. Guided by our core values, we aim to foster personal growth, inspire leadership, and create a supportive environment where each individual can thrive.

### **Diocese of Northwest Ankole, (Anglican) Church of Uganda**

"We are looking for partners to work with us to address the matters of education, health, food security, household income, clean water, sanitation, hygiene and afforestation. We, therefore, request a partnership in any of these matters, especially assisting the youth and children to attain education so that they might be released from poverty and ignorance." – The Rt. ### **Reformed Lutheran Church of Rwanda**

Funds are needed to build a church building for the Lutheran congregation in Ntoma, which currently is using a rental house. "Please, we need to build our own church building in Ntoma. Your prayers for the work of God in Rwanda will continue to be a blessing. Adult members are 120, and the total believers including youth and children are over 300." - Pastor Jean Claude Maniragaba, President, Reformed Lutheran Church of Rwanda
